Academic Programs:	<p>MBA Full Time: a one-year full-time program distributed in 4 modules. Modules first and second contain core courses and the last one contains elective courses, running from March to December.</p> <p>Executive MBA-weekends: classes on Fridays and Saturdays, distributed in 4 modules</p> <p>Master in Financial Engineering: (MIF) Two-year program running from March to December. First year contains classes, second year designed to prepare thesis or final project. Addressed to: <i>Financial:</i> Commercial banks (risk areas, money and balance sheet), investment banks, fund managers and insurance companies. <i>Large companies:</i> Transnational companies and companies that, due to their size, need to actively manage their financial position. <i>Regulatory entities:</i> Central Bank, superintendence, ministries. <i>Consulting companies and study departments.</i> Independent professionals to deepen knowledge in quantitative finance to perform as specialized consultants. Some of the courses in English.</p> <p>Master in Innovation & Entrepreneurship (MIE): One-year program distributed in three trimesters, addressed to Executives and Managers with the responsibility to develop competitive strategies for their companies through innovative projects, and with the aim to become senior managers.</p> <p>Master in Financial Management: One or two year program, addressed to Executives and Professionals with previous knowledge in Accounting and Finance, who need to develop financial tools for an optimal performance and financial decision making.</p>
Application Requirements:	To apply to the MBA or Master program for an exchange period, students should currently be enrolled in an MBA or a Master program at a university with an in-force exchange program agreement.
Application documents required:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Student Application Form * Curriculum Vitae * A recent academic transcript, issued by the applicant's university, in Spanish or English * 2 passport-size photos <p>The original documents must be sent by the applicant to the address indicated in the Student Application Form.</p>
Tuition Fee:	The students from partner universities will not have to pay tuition fee for their exchange period at UAI.
Courses:	<p>According to the program requirements, the course selection indicated in the Student Application Form will have to be approved by the academic committee of the pertinent Master.</p> <p>The MBA and Master courses are listing and displayed on the "Guidelines to Apply"</p>

Application Deadlines:	Up to 45 days prior to the relevant module start. Once nomination is received, our Graduate Exchange Office contacts directly the applicant to provide the application package.

Compliance With Laws	<p>Chilean law requires that every foreign student obtains an identification card (Rut) during the period its exchange program lasts; therefore it is mandatory that he/she makes the necessary steps to get it once he/she arrives to the country. Student Visa is required. Exchange students must have a demonstrable Health and Accident Insurance coverage during the exchange period.</p>
